The Chairman requested the IQAC coordinator present the progressive report of IQAC to the members of the Academic Council. The members were satisfied and approved.


**Item XXXI :** Any Others.

The members appreciated the efforts of the Management, Principal, and faculty members of KSRCAS for effectively implementing the recommendations of the 22<sup>nd</sup> Academic Council meeting, thereby contributing significantly to academic excellence. The following recommendations and suggestions were made by the Academic Council members during the meeting:

- **NET/SET Coaching Classes:** Members recommended allotting dedicated NET/SET coaching classes and suggested nominating one faculty member to organize and coordinate these coaching sessions.
- **Short-Term Courses:** It was recommended that departments offer short-term certificate courses, either in online or offline mode, focusing on areas beneficial to the student community such as management, finance, and other emerging domains.
- **Tamil Kanini Course:** The council recommended the introduction of a Tamil Kanini (Computing in Tamil) course to be offered by the Department of Tamil.
- **Life Science Initiatives:** The Life Science Departments has taken initiatives such as Mushroom Cultivation, Azolla Cultivation and Vermicompost Production. Members suggested to introduce and commercialize the product based on local needs and extending similar public outreach activities in all departments.
- **Internal Assessment - Attendance-Based Marks:** The committee proposed a revised structure for attendance-based marks under internal assessment as follows:
  - 91% - 100% : 5 Mark
  - 86% - 90% : 4 Mark
  - 81% - 85% : 3 Mark
  - 76% - 80% : 2 Mark
  - 75% : 1 Mark

- **Faculty Development Programmes (FDPs):** Members recommended the college to organize Faculty Development Programmes focusing on key academic areas such as domain Specific, NAAC, Outcome-Based Education (OBE) and National Education Policy (NEP).
- **Alumni Engagement:** The council emphasized strengthening the alumni network and suggested organizing an **Alumni Day** event to enhance alumni interaction and involvement.
- **Research and Grants:** Faculty members were encouraged to actively apply for research, workshop and conference grants from various funding agencies. Additionally, members stressed the importance of enhancing research output and increasing patent publications.

To conclude the meeting, Dr. M. Venkatesh, Controller of Examinations (CoE), proposed a vote of thanks and expressed gratitude to the Academic Council members for their valuable insights and recommendations in achieving academic excellence.
