Inter-Collegiate Meet List of Events and Rules On Stage

1. Solo/Group Dance

- i. Group dance, 3-8 participants are allowed per team (Duration:4 minutes)
- ii. Song should be in pen drive and mobile also.
- iii. Vulgarity and obscenity will not be entertained in any form.
- iv. The participants in group dance should be registered individually.
- v. The decision of the judges will be final.

2. Solo Song

- i. Each contestant will be given with the maximum of 5 minutes to sing a song
- ii. Each contestant is free to select his/her songs from any genre of Tamil Cinema
- iii. Lyrics must not contain any profanity and/or political allusions
- iv. The decision of the judges will be final.

3. Adaptune

- i. Different tunes or songs will be given to the participant on the spot.
- ii. The participant should dance according to the change the song played.
- iii. Duration of performance is 2 minutes.
- iv. Vulgarity and obscenity will not be entertained in any form.
- v. The decisions of the judges will be final.

4. **Mime:**

A Mime is an act of a person who uses mime as a theatrical medium or as a performance art.

Miming involves acting out a story through body motions, without the use of speech.

- i. Team event, consisting of maximum 6 to 10 members
- ii. Time duration will be 5 minutes
- iii. The act should not contain any dialogues, lip sync, props or music
- iv. No act shall contain any offensive, obscene, disrespectful actions or gestures
- v. Background music is allowed
- vi. No mythology and religion violence
- vii. Judgment will be based on overall appearance, performance and skills

Off Stage

1. Photography

- i. **Theme**: Provided on the spot; entries unrelated to the theme will be disqualified.
- ii. **Submission**: Submit one original photo in JPEG format (300 DPI, max 10 MB) to **viscom@ksrcas.edu** by **1:00 PM on 21st Feb 2025**, with name and college details.
- iii. **Content**: No offensive or inappropriate material; minor edits are allowed without misrepresentation.
- iv. **Judging**: Based on creativity, theme adherence, technical quality, and impact.

2. Short Film

- i. **Theme & Duration**: Open theme; films must be 3–10 minutes long, including credits.
- ii. **Submission**: Submit one original film (MP4/MOV, 1080p) via Google Drive to **viscom@ksrcas.edu** by **14th Feb 2025**, with team and college details.
- iii. **Content**: No offensive or plagiarized material; non-English films must include English subtitles.
- iv. **Judging**: Based on creativity, storytelling, technical quality, and overall impact. Shortlisted films will be screened during the cultural fest.
- v. **Final Screening**: Teams whose films are shortlisted will be invited to a final screening during the cultural fest.

3. Wealth from Waste

- i. **Team Size:** 2 members per team; no solo participation.
- ii. Eligibility: College/university students with valid ID.
- iii. **Registration:** Pre-register; on-spot entry depends on availability.
- iv. **Theme:** Create useful, innovative products from waste materials.
- v. **Materials:** Bring your own (no hazardous items); basic tools allowed, advanced tools need approval
- vi. **Judging:** Based on innovation, functionality, sustainability, and presentation.
- vii. Conduct: Maintain cleanliness and respect; misconduct leads to disqualification.

4. Cooking without Fire

- i. One team may contain a maximum of 3 members (Total Preparation Time: **2 Hours**)
- ii. Participants are required to report 30 minutes prior to the commencement of the event at the venue
- iii. Cutting of vegetables or fruits should be done on the spot. No prior preparation is allowed.
- iv. Participants should clean their respective workplaces after the competition
- v. Judge's decision will be final and binding
- vi. Participants are required to bring their own cutlery, utensils, and ingredients

5. Treasure Hunt

- i. No skipping clues.
- ii. Collaborate (if playing in teams).
- iii. Stay within designated boundaries.

6. Connections

- i. Two members per team(Duration: **1 Minute**)
- ii. Theme Associating related terms
 - Forming pattern or logical connection
 - Solving puzzles to connect ideas
- iii. Points –10 points for each correct answer
